- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 1.5**% since 2015, falling by 571. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.3**% between 2020 and 2025, losing 99.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 8.4% in Defiance County, OH from 17,339 to 15,878. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 8.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.2% to 58.6% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Defiance County, OH residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.0% below the national average), and **9.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Motor Vehicle Parts Manufacturing.









Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity








Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Defiance County, OH has 6,663 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 7,785.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Defiance County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 11,244 people 55 or older, while there are 12,552 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Defiance County, OH. The national average for an area this size is 15,216 racially diverse people, while there are 5,404 here.




Veterans

Defiance County, OH has 0.93 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime









Top Industry Location Quotient








Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Location Quotient











Top Posted Occupations

Unique Average Monthly Postings




