



# Job Placement

## **What is Job Placement?**

It is an opportunity for Four County Career Center students to begin working in their career field prior to graduation. In essence their lab moves to your workplace! The employer continues to train the student while having a young skilled person on staff throughout the school year. If both parties are satisfied, students can continue to work after graduation.

## **Who qualifies?**

Any senior student that meets the attendance, grades, attitude, skills and good behavior requirements of the program. Exception for juniors on the Bridge Program.

## **What is the Bridge Program?**

Exceptional students can begin job placement at the end of their junior year working throughout the summer and then continue on placement their entire senior year. The criteria for students to qualify is the highest of all the categories of Job Placement.

## **What is Early Job Placement?**

Throughout a student's senior year they can qualify for job placement based on their skill level, grades attendance and attitude. These provide a great opportunity for students to begin their career while still having the "safety net" of the school AND provide a great opportunity for employers to "try out" an employee before committing to a full-time position.
